AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ENHANCED DISPOSITION OF SURPLUS MOTOR VEHICLES  
OWNED BY THE COMMONWEALTH OR AUTHORITIES ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 36A of Chapter 30 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting at the end of the first paragraph the following new paragraph:—  
3 Any state motor vehicle or a motor vehicle owned by a state authority, including construction and snow removal  
4 equipment, that has been determined to be surplus property and no longer useable by the Commonwealth shall be  
5 offered at sale or auction to the cities and towns of the Commonwealth. The Executive Office of Administration and  
6 Finance shall promulgate rules and regulations that establish guidelines for such sales and auctions including but not  
7 limited to notice payment, delivery and liability. Any motor vehicle that is not sold or auctioned off in this manner  
8 may then be made available to the general public for sale and/or auction. For the purpose of this section, motor  
9 vehicle shall be defined as any vehicle constructed and designed for propulsion by power other than muscular  
10 strength including any such vehicles pulled or towed by another motor vehicle.
