# AN ACT AN ACT RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING A SEARCHABLE WEBSITE OF STATE EXPENDITURES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Chapter 7 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby
2	amended by adding after Section 3 the following:
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4	<u>Section 3 1/2</u>
5	
6	(a) As used in this section:
7	1. "Searchable website" means a website that allows the public to search
8	and aggregate information described in subsection (c) at no cost; and
9	2. "Expenditure of state funds" means the expenditure or transfer of any
10	state appropriated or non-appropriated by any department, agency,
11	office, or entity of state government in forms including but not limited
12	to:
13	A. Grants;
14	B. Contracts;
15	C. Subcontracts;
16	D. Purchase orders; and
17	E. Expenditures from Reserve Fund
18	"Expenditure of state funds" does not include the transfer of funds
19	between two departments, agencies, offices, or entities of state
20	government, nor does it include the transfer of state or federal

21	assistance payments to an individual recipient/beneficiary of such
22	assistance payments.
23	
24	(b) No later than January 1, 2010, the Executive Office for Administration and
25	Finance shall develop and operate a single website, accessible by the public at
26	no cost, that includes:
27	1. For each expenditure of state funds, information including, but not
28	limited to:
29	A. Name and municipality of the mailing address of the entity
30	and/or recipients of the funds;
31	B. Amount of expenditure;
32	C. Type of transaction;
33	D. Identity of the department, agency, office, or entity of state
34	government making the expenditure;
35	E. Budget program source for the expenditure;
36	F. Any other information deemed relevant by the Executive
37	Office for Administration and Finance.
38	
39	2. The ability of the user to view information on the website in a format
40	that is searchable and that may be downloaded and managed by the
41	user with appropriate software; and
42	3. The ability of users to provide input to the department regarding the
43	utility of the site and recommendations for improvements.
44	(c) The website shall include information for fiscal year 2009 no later than
45	January 1, 2010; and thereafter, the website shall include information for the
46	most recently completed fiscal year by September 30 <sup>th</sup> of each year.
47	(d) All departments, agencies, and entities of state government shall fully
48	cooperate with the Executive Office for Administration and Finance in
49	compiling and providing all information necessary to comply with the
50	requirements of this section.
51	(e) Nothing in this section shall require disclosure of information deemed
52	confidential by state or federal law.
53	
54	This act shall take effect upon becoming law.
