AN ACT RELATIVE TO DISABLED SERVICE-CONNECTED VETERANS AND THE MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1: Section 1 of said chapter 60A, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after
2 the eight paragraph the following paragraph:-

3 The excise imposed by this section shall not apply to a motor vehicle owned and registered by a
4 veteran, as defined in section 7 of chapter 4, who according to the records of the United States
5 Veterans Administration is one hundred percent service connected **disabled** as defined by title
6 38 section 101 of the Code
