**AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOTOR FUEL PRICING.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 1. Section 3 of chapter 93E of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, after subsection (f),  
2 the following new subsection:—  
3 (g) The division of energy resources shall issue rules and regulations requiring full disclosure by  
4 suppliers of their motor fuel pricing policies to retail dealers. Such disclosure will include a separate listing  
5 of each component contributing to prices, such as the cost of crude oil, refining, marketing,  
6 transportation, equipment, overhead, and profit, along with any rebates, incentives, and market  
7 enhancement allowances. Such regulations shall establish procedures for determining the price a supplier  
8 charges a dealer which it owns or with which it is affiliated.
