AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CIGARETTE EXCISE TAX STAMPING ALLOWANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 30 of chapter 64C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended in lines 36-38 by striking out the words “one dollar and eighty-five cents for each six hundred cigarette
3 excise adhesive stamps purchased, and a proportionate amount for any fraction thereof” and inserting in place
4 thereof the following:- “one percent of the cost of said excise stamp”.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
