### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING DOOR TO DOOR SALES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The chief of police or other designated official shall establish a procedure that will allow residents to notify him that  
2 they do not wish to have any sales agents, sales group or sales supervisors to call upon their premises selling goods  
3 or periodicals. Before a sales agent, sales group or sales supervisors shall commence selling goods and periodicals  
4 door to door, they shall notify the chief of police or other designated official who shall give them a list of persons  
5 and premises who do not want to be called upon by them and they shall comply with such request. A violation of  
6 this paragraph shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 2 ½ years or  
7 both.
