AN ACT RELATIVE TO DISMISSAL OF TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 42 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 3 A principal or superintendent may upon inquiry from a school district state the reasons that a teacher
- 4 was dismissed. A principal shall inquire about the status and service of any applicant for a teaching
- 5 position from any school district that previously employed such applicant.
