AN ACT RELATIVE TO FOOD ALLERGENS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Department of Public Health must report to the legislature within 120 days of the bills
2 passage a comprehensive plan on whether it is feasible to require restaurants to use different utensils,
3 working stations and storage for foods that contain peanut oils or any other allergens that affect
4 individuals who are allergic to peanuts.
