AN ACT RELATIVE TO INTEREST ON RETAINAGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 39G of Chapter 30 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition and as
- 2 amended by Chapter 236 of the Acts of 1998 is hereby further amended by inserting after paragraph six, the
- 3 following new paragraph:-
- 4 At the time of the first payment to the contractor, the awarding authority shall establish an escrow account in a
- 5 financial institution licensed to do business in the Commonwealth. The account shall be set up to maximize the
- 6 return, which is to accumulate. The awarding authority shall then pay into such account each portion of each
- 7 requisition that represents retainage deducted from the amount due the contractor for periodic payment. The
- 8 payment of such retainage into the escrow account shall be made simultaneously with the payments to the
- 9 contractor for periodic requisitions. The proceeds of the escrow account including accumulated interest shall be
- 10 payable to the contractor in accordance with the provisions of this section.
