**AN ACT RELATIVE TO JOSEPH BOUDREAU'S STATE POLICE PENSION.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose which is to  
2 forthwith make certain pension funds available, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law,  
3 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

5 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the state board of retirement shall pay a  
6 member survivor allowance to Tavesri-Jantima Boudreau, widow of Joseph R. Joseph R. J. Boudreau, a  
7 retired state police officer, effective on the date of his death February 2, 2007 equal to the amount she  
8 would have received if he had named her as his beneficiary.
