**AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR UNCOMPENSATED ELECTED OFFICIALS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1   Section 4 (1) (o) of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2   amended by inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-
  
- 3   Any member who has served as a selectmen, alderman, city councilor, school committee member or
- 4   town moderator as the result of election by the direct vote of the people, in which position he received
- 5   no compensation, may establish credit for such service by depositing in the annuity savings fund of the
- 6   system of which he is a member a sum equal to the amount which would have been paid into such
- 7   period if such position had been compensated at the rate of twenty-five hundred dollars per year, plus
- 8   regular interest to the date of payment; provided, however, that the provisions of this paragraph shall
- 9   not apply to any member first elected on or after January 1, 1996.
