## AN ACT RELATIVE TO LEGISLATIVE ETHICS TRAINING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Chapter 3 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 43 the following section:-

- Section 43A. All members of the ethics committee of the general court shall receive in depth education
- 5 and training on ethics' law, interviewing skills and investigatory procedures. All actions of said
- 6 committees shall be made public, including but not limited to advisory opinions. The ethics committees
- 7 shall conduct an education and training seminar for members of the general court at the
- 8 commencement of each session. Issues beyond the scope of professional expertise or legislative rules
- 9 shall be referred to the appropriate resources.
