### AN ACT RELATIVE TO COMMUNITY PRESERVATION FUNDS FOR SEAWALL REPAIRS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 44B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by striking out, in line 6, the word “and”.

4           SECTION 2. Section 6 of chapter 44B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby  
5 amended by inserting after the word “housing”, in line 7, the following words:-

7           And in coastal communities that adopt the provisions of this act, not less than 10 per cent for the preservation of  
8 public infrastructure through beach nourishment, dune restoration, and seawall maintenance and reconstruction.
