## AN ACT RELATIVE TO DISTINCTIVE BRONZE STAR MOTOR VEHICLE PLATES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The 17<sup>th</sup> paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-

3           Notwithstanding the preceding, a person on active duty, drilling reservists and national  
4 guard personnel who has received the Bronze Star shall be entitled to be issued a plate with a  
5 distinctive emblem affixed thereto signifying his receipt of the Bronze Star.
