AN ACT RELATIVE TO STATE TRADEMARKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 110H of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 195 of 2006, is hereby
2 amended by striking out paragraph (e) and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

4 (e) The application shall be accompanied by 1 specimen showing the mark as actually used.

6 SECTION 2. Said chapter 110H is hereby further amended by adding the following section:-

8 Section 18. The intent of this chapter is to provide a system of state trademark registration and protection
9 substantially consistent with the federal system of trademark registration and protection under the Trademark Act
10 of 1946, as amended. To that end, the construction given the federal Act should be examined as persuasive
11 authority for interpreting and construing this chapter to the extent of the consistency in the language.

13 SECTION 3. Paragraph (b) of section 4.01 of chapter 156D of the General Laws, as amended by section 3 of chapter
14 195 of 2006, is hereby further amended by striking out clause (6) and inserting in place thereof the following
15 clause:-
