## AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALE OF LIQUOR LICENSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Upon the acceptance of this section by a city or town, said city or town may assess  
2 and collect a fee for any license issued by the city or town pursuant to chapter 138 of the General Laws  
3 when such license is sold by the licensee to another licensee. Said fee shall be assessed at the time of  
4 approval of the transfer of the license by the city or town. Said fee shall be established by the city or  
5 town in an amount not to exceed 25 per cent of the amount paid for the license.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
