AN ACT RELATIVE TO FALSELY ASSUMING TO BE A PUBLIC OFFICIAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 33 of chapter 268 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by striking out, in lines 11 and 12, the words "a fine of not more than four hundred
- dollars or by imprisonment for not more than one year" and inserting in place thereof the following
- 4 words:- a fine of not more than \$5,000 or by imprisonment in a jail or house of correction for not more
- 5 than 2 ½ years or by both such fine and imprisonment.
