AN ACT RELATIVE TO SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 68 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out the sixth sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— A
- 3 school committee may assess fees to transported students up to an amount sufficient to cover the costs
- 4 incurred by the district; provided, however, that a transported student whose transportation is required
- 5 under any other general or special law or who is eligible for free or reduced lunch under the federal
- 6 school lunch program shall not be required to pay the fee; and provided further, that a school
- 7 committee may exempt families at other income levels as it may determine or offer discounts for
- 8 families who pay transportation fees for multiple students; and provided further, that fees may not be
- 9 assessed based on distance from the schoolhouse.
