## AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR KEITH BIANCHINI, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 1. *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to  
2 establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of corrections,  
3 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate  
4 preservation of the public convenience.

- 6 3. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the department  
7 of corrections shall establish a sick leave bank for KEITH BIANCHINI, an employee of the  
8 department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,  
9 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by KEITH BIANCHINI. Whenever KEITH  
10 BIANCHINI terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave  
11 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave  
12 bank. Sick leave bank days may not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability  
13 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
