AN ACT RELATIVE TO CRIMINAL OFFENDER RECORDS OF MINORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 172I the following
2 section:—Section 172J. Notwithstanding section 172, section 60 or 60A of chapter 119 or any other general or
3 special law to the contrary, primarily engaged in providing services to children 18 years or less to adults 60 years
4 of age or older shall obtain the youthful offender and adjudication of delinquency data concerning sex offender, as
5 defined in section 178C, of employees 18 years of age or less.
