## AN ACT RELATIVE TO HANDICAPPED PARKING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by striking out, in line 291 the words “of \$500 for a first offense and \$1,000 for a  
3 second or subsequent offense” and inserting in place thereof the followings words:- of \$1,000 for a first  
4 offense and \$2,500 for a second or subsequent offense .

- 6 SECTION 2. Said section 2 of said chapter 90 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby further  
7 amended by striking out, in lines 295 to 297, the words “for a period of 30 days for a first offense, for a  
8 period of 90 days for a second offense and for a period of one year for a third or subsequent offense”  
9 and inserting in place thereof the following words:- for a period of 1 year for a first offense, 3 years for a  
10 second offense and 5 years for a third or subsequent offense .
