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**AN ACT RELATIVE TO HEALTH INSURANCE CLAIMS OF EMPLOYEES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1    SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, health care insurers must provide  
2    benefits to insured claimants seeking reasonable and necessary medical services in all cases in which an  
3    alleged industrial injury has not been accepted by a workers' compensation insurer, and in all cases prior  
4    to the issuance of a conference order by an administrative judge pursuant to section 10 of chapter 152 of  
5    the General Laws directing the provision of medical benefits under sections 13 and 30 of chapter 152 of  
6    the General Laws.
