AN ACT RELATIVE TO IDENTITY THEFT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 **SECTION 1. Section 30 of chapter 266 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2004 Edition is hereby amended by**
2 **inserting after the word “chattels”, in line 24, the following words:-- personal identifying information, as defined**
3 **in subsection (a).**

5 **SECTION 2. Subsection (a) of section 37E of said chapter 266 ,as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting**
6 **after the word “loss” , in line 16, the following words:-- or any person whose personal identifying information**
7 **has been used without the express authorization of that person.**

9 **SECTION 3. Said section 37E of said chapter 266, as so appearing is hereby further amended by adding the**
10 **following subsection:--**

11 **(f) Any additional violations of section 30 committed as a result of violating this section, including, but**
12 **not limited to, obtaining money, credit, goods, services, objects with a monetary value, identification cards or**
13 **other evidence of such person’s identity may be prosecuted and punished in any county where the defendant**
14 **had possession of property alleged to have been stolen or the county in which the victim of the violation**
15 **resides.**
