AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR CERTAIN COURT OFFICERS EMPLOYED  
IN THE TRIAL COURT DEPARTMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any court officer who was classified as a per diem and
- 2 was entitled to benefits under a collective bargaining agreement shall be entitled to buy back for retirement
- 3 purposes the years for which he or she did not receive retirement credit while covered under the collective
- 4 bargaining agreement.
