AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CUSTODIAL AND NON TEACHING EMPLOYEES OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 59B of Chapter 71 is hereby amended by adding the following words at the end of the  
2 first paragraph: “In the case of custodial, maintenance and non-teaching positions, the hiring, promotion  
3 and firing of such employees shall be completed in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 31 of the  
4 general laws provided that said positions are classified as civil service positions. For those positions not  
5 covered by civil service, the hiring, promotion and firing of such employees shall be completed in  
6 accordance with the provisions of the existing collective bargaining agreement.”
