## AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING MOTORIZED SCOOTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition is
- 2 hereby amended by striking the following in line 143, "or a non-pedal bicycle which has a motor, with a
- 3 cylinder capacity not exceeding fifty cubic centimeters, an automatic transmission, and which is capable
- 4 of a maximum speed of no more than thirty miles per hour".
- 5 Further amending by adding in line 150 after the word propulsion, "or a non-pedal bicycle which has a
- 6 motor, with a cylinder capacity not exceeding fifty cubic centimeters, an automatic transmission, and
- 7 which is capable of a maximum speed of no more than thirty miles per hour".
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1E of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition is
- 9 hereby amended by adding the following in line 14 after the word sunrise, "unless said motorized
- scooter is manufacturally equipped with head, tail, and brake lights".
- 11 Further amending by adding in line 19 after the word scooter, "unless said scooter has manufactured
- 12 seating for said passenger. Owners of said motorized scooters are subject to the same registration and
- insurance requirements of motor vehicles as defined in the General Laws."
