AN ACT RELATIVE TO SAFE DRIVING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Massachusetts Highway Department shall conduct a study of the use of certain
- 2 mechanical devices to prevent vehicles from erroneously entering the highway on the off- ramp instead of
- 3 the on-ramp in locations where drivers have consistently made said error, including Exits 13 through 16
- 4 on Route 128 northbound. The department shall report its findings to the Joint Committee on
- 5 Transportation no later than December 30, 2009.
