**AN ACT RELATIVE TO FINES FOR REFUSAL TO STOP DURING POLICE PURSUIT.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   Section 25 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by adding the following  
2 paragraph:—

3                   Any person who, while operating or in charge of a motor vehicle, when being pursued by a police officer  
4 in an official police vehicle displaying lights and siren, who refuses or neglects to stop, shall be punished by a fine  
5 of not less than one thousand nor more than ten thousand dollars and imprisonment for not less than two and  
6 one-half nor more than five years, or both such fine and imprisonment.
