AN ACT TO DENY CONVICTED SEX OFFENDERS ACCESS TO PUBLIC SUBSIDIZED HOUSING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 26 of Chapter 121B of the General Laws, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (o), the
2 following subsection:--

3 (p):- Shall deny access to public housing facilities that are subsidized by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for all
4 persons who have been convicted of Level 2 or Level 3 sex offenses in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
