AN ACT RELATIVE TO LEGISLATION TO PROTECT THE PRIVACY OF EMPLOYEES OF
MUNICIPALITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 109A the following section:—
- 2 Section 109B. Any city or town which accepts the provisions of this section may adopt a by-law regulating or
- 3 prohibiting the disclosure of the residential addresses of its employees to unauthorized persons.
