AN ACT RELATIVE TO LEGISLATION TO PROTECT THE PRIVACY OF EMPLOYEES OF MUNICIPALITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 109A the following section:— Section 109B. Any city or town which accepts the provisions of this section may adopt a by-law regulating or prohibiting the disclosure of the residential addresses of its employees to unauthorized persons.
