# AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE IN THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OFFICE TO STUDY ESTABLISHING MUNICIPALLY-SPONSORED AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** The Office of the Attorney General shall convene a task force to assess the potential costs
- 2 and benefits of municipally sponsored auto insurance programs, and draft standards and regulations by
- 3 which such insurance programs shall operate. Regulations shall include establishing a State-run umbrella
- 4 network under which the municipal auto insurance programs shall be joined, for reinsurance purposes
- 5 and cost leveling among low risk and high risk localities. This study shall include assessing potential
- 6 revenue which Towns and Cities could derive from local auto insurance programs, such revenue to pay
- 7 for services required for safe automobile traffic: street maintenance, traffic lights, police services, and
- 8 snow plowing.

- 10 **SECTION 2.** The task force shall submit a report, including draft standards and regulations, to the
- appropriate committees on municipal finance and automobile insurance within 6 months of the
- 12 effective date of this act.
