AN ACT REGULATING CONDUCT AT POLLING PLACES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 65 of Chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding, after the first paragraph, the following paragraph:—
- No rule, regulation or provision of law shall prohibit a candidate on the current election ballot from
- 4 greeting voters and soliciting votes within 150 feet of the entrance door to the building where a polling
- 5 place is located, provided that he/she is not distributing campaign material nor obstructing voters entering
- 6 the polls.
