## AN ACT RELATIVE TO CHILD LABOR LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended in section 78A, by striking out the second and third sentences and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following sentence:-
- 4 "The citation may require a person: (1) to comply immediately with sections 56 to 104, inclusive: (2) for
- 5 each willful violation of any of those sections, to pay a civil penalty of not more than \$250 for the first
- offense, \$500 for the second offense, and \$2,500 for the third and each subsequent offense; and (3) for
- 7 each violation that is not willful of any of those sections, to pay a civil penalty of not more than \$100 for
- 8 the first offense, \$200 for the second offense, and \$500 for the third and each subsequent offense."
