## AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN OPTION B AND OPTION C RETIREES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, a member who  
2 is receiving a lesser retirement allowance in accordance with the terms of Option b or Option C of  
3 Subdivision of Section (to be filled in by filer) of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, from a retirement  
4 system that accepts the provisions of this act, shall have his retirement allowance determined according  
5 to the table of mortality selected by the commission pursuant to Section 336 of Chapter 47 of the Acts  
6 of 2004 and whatever section governs the Option B amount. For purposes of the Act, the State  
7 Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement Systems shall be deemed to have accepted the provisions of  
8 this act.
