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**AN ACT RELATIVE TO CONVICTIONS OF MOTOR VEHICLE VIOLATIONS AND LICENSE  
SUSPENSIONS AND REVOCATIONS IN OTHER STATES OR COUNTRIES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 22 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the word “commonwealth”, in line 54, the following words:— ; provided, however, that  
3 said violation occurred within the 24 month period immediately preceding the date of receipt of the official notice  
4 by the registrar; and, provided, further, that the registrar acts within 90 days of receipt of said notice.  
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6 SECTION 2. Said section 22 of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by inserting after the  
7 word “hearing”, in line 67, the following words:-; provided, however, that said suspension or revocation of a license  
8 or right to operate occurred within the 24 month period immediately preceding the date of receipt of the official  
9 notice by the registrar; and provided, further, that the registrar acts within 90 days of receipt of said notice

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
