## AN ACT RELATIVE TO STAFFING OF AMBULANCES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1            SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary the commissioner of the
- 2 department of public health is hereby directed to establish regulations regarding the staffing of
- 3 ambulances based on the following considerations:
  - 4        Emergency services responding to calls in municipalities of 10,000 residents or less can staff an
  - 5 ambulance with 1 first responder acting as driver who is trained in CPR and basic first aid and 1
  - 6 emergency services technician of a certification level that is appropriate for the needs of the patient.
  - 7        The aforementioned change in regulations shall only apply when the staffing levels regulated in section
  - 8 170.305 in the Massachusetts Department of Public Health CMR 105 cannot be met in sufficient time to
  - 9 answer the emergency call.
