**AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR EDWARD KAZANJIAN.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary the Massachusetts Teachers'  
2 Retirement Board is hereby authorized and directed to allow Mr. Edward Kazanjian to purchase as  
3 creditable service the time he was employed at the Massachusetts Association of School Business  
4 Officials Cooperative Corporation, March 1, 1983 through December 31, 1998; provided that no credit  
5 shall be allowed unless said Edward Kazanjian, has paid into the Annuity Savings Fund of the teachers'  
6 retirement system by the date of his retirement, in one sum or in installments, upon such terms and  
7 conditions as the board may prescribe, an amount equal to the deductions that would have been withheld  
8 had Mr. Edward Kazanjian continued in service, as determined by the board, together with buyback  
9 interest.
