#### AN ACT PROTECTING CHILDREN FROM DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 13A of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:--
- 3 (d) Whoever commits an assault or an assault and battery upon another within a dwelling and in
- 4 the presence of a child under 16 years of age shall be punished by imprisonment in the state
- prison for not more than 5 years or in the house of correction for not more than 2½ years, or by a
- 6 fine of not more than \$5,000, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Furthermore, the law
- 7 enforcement agency filing the charges shall provide the department of social services, as
- 8 established in chapter 18B, with a notice of the charges, to be used at the department's
- 9 discretion.
