AN ACT RELATIVE TO CLASSROOM MATERIALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 70 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (e) the following subsection: (f)
- 3 additional funds may be allotted if a districts' books and other classroom materials reported per
- 4 paragraph (i) of section one of chapter sixty-nine are found to be inadequate. These additional
- 5 funds may be awarded for the purchasing of new materials which have been found effective by
- 6 use in other districts.
