## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO OPEN MEETINGS OF GOVERNMENTAL BODIES WITHOUT THE PRESENCE OF A QUORUM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 23B of chapter 39 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding after the sixth paragraph the following new paragraph:—
- 3 A meeting for which notice is filed and posted under the preceding paragraph shall not be
- 4 convened in open or executive session unless and until a quorum of the governmental body is present.
- 5 If such a quorum is not present within twenty minutes after the time stated in the notice, the members
- 6 then present may convene in open session for the sole purpose of scheduling a subsequent meeting of
- 7 the governmental body, and shall not deliberate any other matter. A meeting scheduled under this
- 8 paragraph shall otherwise conform to the requirements of this section.
