AN ACT RELATIVE TO SHORT TERM INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 108 of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
- 2 Section 31 of Chapter 205 of the Acts of 2007, is hereby amended by inserting after the first
- 3 sentence the following new sentence:-
- 4 The commissioner of insurance may approve insurance providing benefits for confinement in a
- 5 convalescent or nursing home, assisted living facility or a charitable home for the aged that is not
- 6 marketed or solicited as long-term care insurance.
