AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EQUITABLE ASSESSMENT OF BANK FEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 167D of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 3 and 4, the following: - “, established for  
3 personal, family or household purposes,”.

4 SECTION 2. Section 41A of chapter 171 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official  
5 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 3 and 4, the following: - “, established for  
6 personal, family or household purposes,”.
