**AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF CREDIT CARDS FOR PAYMENT TO THE
COMMONWEALTH.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the governor shall
2 ensure that secretaries of the various departments and executive offices of the commonwealth,
3 with the exception of the department of revenue, implement a system for the acceptance of
4 credit cards as a valid form of payment for all licenses, services, fines, and other transactions as
5 established under chapter 14 of the General Laws.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective on July 1, 2010.
