Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 4 is hereby amended by inserting after the phrase, "...the services of an attorney.", the following
- 5 sentence:-"The accused shall also be afforded the opportunity to place a 2nd call to make arrangements
- 6 for the care of a dependent person or pet."
