AN ACT RELATIVE TO UNSOLICITED CREDIT CARDS, CHECKS, AND VOUCHERS BY  
MAIL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1.

3   Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, no resident of the  
4   Commonwealth shall be liable for unsolicited credit cards, checks, or vouchers sent to them by  
5   commercial banks, mortgage lenders, or any others authorized to do business in the Commonwealth.  
6   Such redeemable items, if cashed, shall be the responsibility of said vendors, unless it can be proven the  
7   addressee personally redeemed the item.
