PETITION OF:

Chapter 94 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2002 Official Edition is hereby amended
by inserting at the end thereof, the following section:-

Section 307D. A cigarette or any of its component parts (including the tobacco, filter, or 3 paper) containing, as a constituent (including a smoke constituent) or additive, an artificial or 4 natural flavor (other than tobacco or menthol) or an herb or spice, including strawberry, grape, 5 orange, cinnamon, pineapple, vanilla, coconut, licorice, cocoa, chocolate, cherry, or coffee, that 6 is a characterizing flavor of the tobacco product or tobacco smoke shall be prohibited from being 7 sold or marketed in the Commonwealth. Nothing in this paragraph shall be construed to limit the 8 Attorney General's authority to take action under this section. Nothing in this paragraph shall 9 prohibit the manufacture or sale of clove cigarettes, so called. 10
