AN ACT RELATIVE TO BROADENED ELIGIBILITY FOR RELIEF FROM DISPROPORTIONATE
PROPERTY TAX BURDENS..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (k) of section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as inserted by section
2 80 of Chapter 127 of the Acts of 1999, is hereby amended by striking from paragraph (2) the words:

3 - B, who is 65 years of age or older,

4 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall apply to all taxable years beginning on or after January 1,
5 2004.
