AN ACT IMPROVING ACCESSIBILITY TO COMMUTER RAIL STATIONS IN THE CITY OF  
NEWTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the
- 2 Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority shall expend such funds as are necessary for the
- 3 design and construction of improvements to the Auburndale, West Newton and Newtonville
- 4 commuter rail stations to ensure that said stations are accessible, functional, and safe for use by
- 5 persons with disabilities.
