AN ACT TO IMPROVE ACCESS TO CHILD AND ADOLESCENT MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 22 of Chapter 32A of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out
2 the last paragraph, inserted by section 1 of chapter 80 of the acts of 2000, and inserting in place
3 thereof the following paragraph:--

4 For the purposes of this section, “licensed mental health professional” shall mean a licensed
5 physician who specializes in the practice of psychiatry, a licensed psychologist, a licensed
6 independent clinical social worker, a licensed mental health counselor, a licensed nurse mental
7 health clinical specialist, or a licensed educational psychologist within the lawful scope of
8 practice for such educational psychologist.

9 SECTION 2.

10 Section 47B of Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the next to

11 the last paragraph, inserted by section 2 of chapter 80 of the acts of 2000, and inserting in place
12 thereof the following paragraph:--

13 For the purposes of this section, “licensed mental health professional” shall mean a licensed
14 physician who specializes in the practice of psychiatry, a licensed psychologist, a licensed
15 independent clinical social worker, a licensed mental health counselor, a licensed nurse mental
16 health clinical specialist, or a licensed educational psychologist within the lawful scope of
17 practice for such educational psychologist.

18 SECTION 3.

19 Section A of Chapter 176A of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the next to
20 the last paragraph, inserted by section 4 of chapter 80 of the acts of 2000, and inserting in place
21 thereof the following paragraph:--

22 For the purposes of this section, “licensed mental health professional” shall mean a licensed
23 physician who specializes in the practice of psychiatry, a licensed psychologist, a licensed
24 independent clinical social worker, a licensed mental health counselor, a licensed nurse mental
25 health clinical specialist, or a licensed educational psychologist within the lawful scope of
26 practice for such educational psychologist.

27 SECTION 4.

28 Section 4A of Chapter 176B of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the next to
29 the last paragraph, inserted by section 6 of chapter 80 of the acts of 2000, and inserting in place
30 thereof the following paragraph:--

31 For the purposes of this section, “licensed mental health professional” shall mean a licensed
32 physician who specializes in the practice of psychiatry, a licensed psychologist, a licensed
33 independent clinical social worker, a licensed mental health counselor, a licensed nurse mental
34 health clinical specialist, or a licensed educational psychologist within the lawful scope of
35 practice for such educational psychologist.

36 SECTION 5.

37 Section 4M of Chapter 176G of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the next to
38 the last paragraph, inserted by section 10 of chapter 80 to the acts of 2000, and inserting in place
39 thereof the following paragraph:--

40 For the purposes of this section, “licensed mental health professional” shall mean a licensed
41 physician who specializes in the practice of psychiatry, a licensed psychologist, a licensed
42 independent clinical social worker, a licensed mental health counselor, a licensed nurse mental
43 health clinical specialist, or a licensed educational psychologist within the lawful scope of
44 practice for such educational psychologist.

45 SECTION 6. This act shall apply to all policies, contracts, agreements, plans and certificates of
46 insurance issued or delivered within or without the commonwealth on or after March 1, 2010,
47 and to all policies, contracts, agreements, plans and certificates of insurance in effect before that
48 date upon renewal or after March 1, 2010.
